Jgpn16 Gpn16 rnc2005 NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that there will be heard before a Judge of the Superior Court of Rockdale County on the 2nd day of January, 2024 at 8:45 a.m., at the Rockdale County Courthouse in Conyers, Georgia the case of the State of Georgia v. Rockdale County Public Facilities Authority and Rockdale County, Georgia, Civil Action No. No.2023-CV-2729, the same being a proceeding to confirm and validate the issuance by the Rockdale County Public Facilities Authority (the Authority) of its Revenue Bonds, Series 2024, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$110,000,000 (Series 2024 Bonds) for the purpose of (a) acquiring, constructing and equipping a judicial and administration complex (the Project), (b) funding capitalized interest (if any) and (c) paying the costs of issuing the Series 2024 Bonds. In such proceeding, the Court will also pass upon the validity and enforceability of (a) an Intergovernmental Contract, dated as of March 1, 2024 or the first day of the month in which the Series 2024 Bonds are issued (the Contract), between the Authority and the County, pursuant to which the Authority will agree to (a) issue the Series 2024 Bonds and (b) sell the Project to the County, and the County will agree to, among other things, (a) buy the Project from the Authority, (b) acquire, construct, equip and operate the Project, (c) pay the Authority amounts sufficient to enable the Authority to pay the principal of, redemption premium (if any) and interest on the Series 2024 Bonds and any additional bonds hereafter issued as the same become due (the Contract Payments) and (d) levy an annual ad valorem property tax, unlimited as to rate or amount, on all property in the County subject to such tax in order to make such Contract Payments. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 36-82-100 (the Audit Statute), the Authority notifies all interested parties that no independent performance audit or performance review will be conducted with respect to the Series 2024 Bonds. However, the Authority will continue to ensure that the proceeds of the Series 2024 Bonds are expended efficiently and economically, as intended by the Audit Statute. Any resident of the County, or any other person wherever residing who has a right to object, may become a party to these proceedings. 12/20 27
